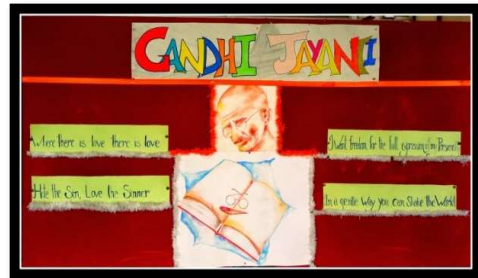
TEACHER'S DAY SEPTEMBER 5TH

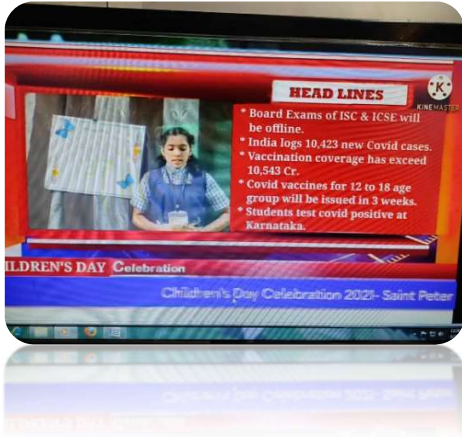
CHILDREN'S DAY NOVEMBER 14TH

Hope Aichwald will help her. We have six new students of which one is a boy. He is also a from a very poor family. But talented, due to the sudden death of his father he cannot afford to study. He also needs our special help. "Please help", said to me the crying mother of this kid, when I had visited our sponsor students.

ADVANCE MONEY TAKEN FROM THE DIOCESE

As per the last proposed budget the money received from Aichwald was less. We could not request immediately for the money again. However, with the request the financial administer lend some lakhs of rupees for the need of our students and school. We have agreed to return when the Aichwald helps.
